<b>Ticket designator</b>	AC
<b>Account code/corporate id</b>	ACC99
<b>Fare basis</b>	As per public fares, refer to GDS.
<b>OSI entry</b>	The clients ABN or NZBN must be added as an OSI in each booking. Failure to include ABN or NZBN as OSI on the booking will result in the issuance of an agency debit memo (ADM) by the airline's revenue accounts department to retrieve the difference between the applicable published fare and the fare advantage fare.
<b>Flight application</b>	Refer to GDS.
<b>Seasons</b>	As per public fares, refer to GDS.
<b>Reservations and ticketing</b>	Refer to GDS for ticketing time limit. Tickets must be issued on VA ticket stock (VA 795). Tickets must be issued by electronic ticketing. Availability of point of sale discount is limited. They do not apply to all booking classes, flight or days, even within a specified offer period, unless otherwise specified.
<b>Important note</b>	The accelerate account code/ID must be used when pricing the fares to ensure the correct discount and fare basis is applied which will then ensure that the relevant fare conditions are also applied. When booking non-discounted fare classes, the same tour code and OSI details must be added at time of ticketing for reporting purposes.
<b>Reissue/exchange process</b>	All Virgin Australia tickets issued for an accelerate client must show ticket designator (/AC) to qualify for appropriate discount. Important notice: accelerate fare cannot be reissued/ exchanged onto any other fare with different tour code and/or ticket designator or any other Virgin Australia private fare. Accelerate fare can be reissued/exchanged onto a public fare, subject to the conditions of the ticketed fare.
<b>Minimum stay</b>	Nil.
<b>Maximum stay</b>	Refer to GDS.
<b>Stopovers and transfers</b>	Refer to GDS.
<b>Construction and combinations</b>	Refer to GDS.
<b>Taxes and surcharges</b>	Taxes/surcharges/fees apply – must be collected prior to tickets being issued. Additional taxes may be payable direct at certain airports.
<b>Endorsement</b>	The original and the reissued ticket must be annotated - restrictions apply/non-end and penalties apply, in the endorsement box.
<b>Child discounts</b>	Not permitted.
<b>Unaccompanied minors</b>	Not permitted.
<b>Routings</b>	Refer to GDS for applicable route map.
<b>Penalties</b>	Changes: as per fare rules. Note: local reissue/service fees may apply. Cancellations: as per fare rules. Name changes: refer to fare rules/gds.
<b>Form of payment</b>	Cash or credit card.
<b>Commission</b>	Refer to commercial agreement. Contracted commission should be claimed at the time of ticketing if applicable.
<b>General</b>	Subject to change or cancellation without notice. Note: this fare should auto quote in the gds. If the fare does not auto quote, please refer to the GDS to ensure the itinerary adheres to the fare rules.

All flights must be booked via the Virgin Australia Business Portal, the Virgin Australia Guest Contact Centre or a registered self-ticketing Travel Management Company and are not available via the Virgin Australia public website. Fare Advantage discounts are available on all domestic flights, Trans Tasman and international short haul flights using Virgin Australia only. Fare Advantage discounts will not be applied to sale fares or other tactical fares Virgin Australia offers from time to time. Members travelling on upgraded fares purchased with Points or any other subsidised means of upgrades on Virgin Australia or our partner airlines will earn Status Credits based on original purchased fare class.
