



Virgin Australia expands partnership with Singapore Airlines

Virgin Australia and Singapore Airlines have resumed the sale of Virgin Australia codeshare flights to a host of destinations on Singapore Airlines' global network for seamless travel between Australia, Asia, Africa and Europe.

The move is the next step in returning the carrier's partnership to pre-pandemic operations, following the resumption of redemption bookings and mileage/Points conversion for KrisFlyer and Velocity members earlier this year. While miles and Points earn has remained unchanged throughout the pandemic, the announcement unlocks the full rewards and benefits of the partnership for customers as demand for international travel continues to improve.

The two carriers will continue to work closely to expand codeshare flights to more destinations across the Singapore Airlines' network in the coming weeks, subject to regulatory approval.
