Completion of Virgin Australia's Economy fare class realignment

Virgin Australia would like to advise that a fare class realignment will be completed 19 January 2022. The changes finalise the introduction of the Economy Choice and Flex fare brands, which are part of an ongoing commitment to deliver better value and choice for customers when they fly with Virgin Australia.

The completion of this work will see additional fare classes added to Virgin Australia's Economy fare inventory, so please familiarise yourself with the changes summarised below. These additional price points will be visible in your GDS from 22 January 2022.

What is changing?

- F, I, R, O and P class will now be available to book under the Economy Choice fare brand
- W class will now be available to book under the Economy Flex fare brand
- The class display sequence will change from FAJCDIWROYBHKLENVQTSM to JCDZYBWHKLREONVPQTISFUM

Agents are advised to ticket any existing bookings by 23:59 (AEST) 17 January 2022 to maintain existing fare levels, as the roll out of the new fare levels will commence on 18 January 2022 (Brisbane) and your Global Distribution System will be updated with new fare levels by 19 January 2022 (Brisbane).
