

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR FLIGHT

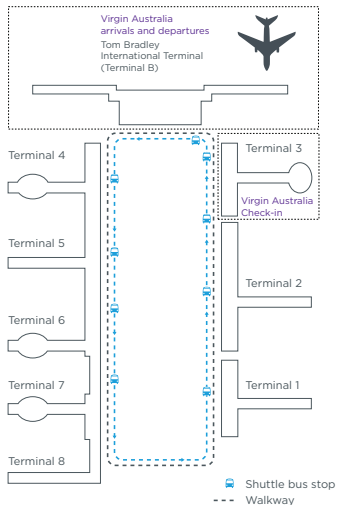
Ahead of your flight **arriving at Los Angeles International Airport**, we would like to assist you to navigate through current changes at the airport terminal.

CONNECTING ONWARDS FROM LOS ANGELES?

1. All Virgin Australia flights will arrive at Tom Bradley International Terminal. Upon arrival, collect your bags and proceed through customs.
2. Once you have cleared customs, check the departure information board to confirm which terminal your onward flight departs from. Flights with Delta Air Lines will generally depart Terminal 2 or 3, however the departure board will give the correct and most recent information.
3. Proceed to the terminal listed and check-in as per usual.

CONNECTING BETWEEN TERMINALS

Tom Bradley International Airport, Terminals 2 and Terminal 3 are approximately a five minute walk from each other. Whilst walking is often the quickest method, there is a free inter-terminal shuttle bus (Route A) that departs every 10 minutes from outside the terminal buildings.

CHECK-IN WITH VIRGIN AUSTRALIA AT TERMINAL 3

1. Virgin Australia Check-in has recently relocated from Terminal 2, to **Terminal 3**.
2. Once you have checked in for your flight at Terminal 3, proceed to Tom Bradley International Terminal via the walkway or shuttle bus.
3. Proceed to security screening and continue through to your allocated gate.

ALREADY HAVE YOUR BOARDING PASS?

Proceed directly to security screening at Tom Bradley International Airport.

CONNECTING BETWEEN TERMINALS

Tom Bradley International Airport, Terminals 2 and Terminal 3 are approximately a five minute walk from each other. Whilst walking is often the quickest method, there is a free inter-terminal shuttle bus (Route A) that departs every 10 minutes from outside the terminal buildings.
